### BREMNES SEASHORE DOES NOT USE ETHOXYQUIN

The antioxidant ethoxyquin is an approved additive that for decades has been added to the fish-meal used in fish feed in order to prevent it from becoming rancid.

Due to a growing concern in the society, and following the precautionary principle, we decided in December 2017 to phase out fish-meal stabilized by ethoxyquin in our fish-feed.

In April 2018 our biggest feed-supplier quit such fishmeal completely, followed by our other feed suppliers a couple of Months later.

By the end of June 2018 no feed given to our salmon contained fish-meal stabilized by ethoxyquin. The level of residues of ethoxyquin in our salmon were far below the acceptable daily intake levels set by European legislation. The levels of ethoxyquin-residues in the salmon reached zero in the early autumn of 2019.
